Product Description

ElectricInsight® depicts how a build is structured and run, empowering users to pinpoint performance problems or conflicts in a parallel build. Developed to work with ElectricAccelerator®, Insight mines information produced by Electric Make® to provide an easy-to-understand, graphical representation of the build structure for performance analysis.

Insight provides detailed information and reports for at-a-glance diagnostics for each job on each host in the build cluster. Users can identify which jobs are performing, when, and with which files. Instead of manually reading through tens of thousands of lines of information in log files, error detection and performance tuning that used to consume hours or days can now occur in a few minutes or seconds.

What's New for Version 4.0

Features and Functionality

- Added the hyperlog feature. The hyperlog presents an augmented version of the familiar build output
 log, leveraging the extra information provided by Electric Make to enable highlighting errors and
 warnings, folding of submake output, and line numbering. Double-clicking any line of log output displays
 the corresponding job's details dialog.
- Added the ability to generate reports from the command-line. With ElectricInsight's command-line
 reporting capability, the product can now be easily integrated to generate batch trend reports as part of a
 build automation system.
 - You can now run these reports from the command-line:
 - ElectricSimulator
 - Job Stats
 - · Job Time by Type
 - · Longest Jobs
 - · Longest Serial Chain
 - Most Read Files
 - The following command-line only reports are new:
 - Build Metrics extracts the content of the <metrics> element in the annotation
 - Build Summary prints the information from the left-side of the main Insight display
 - Export Timeline generates a thumbnail image of the main Insight Jobs & Agents display
- Combined the Job Count by Length and Job Time by Length reports into a report named Job Stats.
- Redesigned the reports API for creating custom reports.
- Updated the toolchain to use TclKit 8.6.

Resolved Issues

- Fixed a Makefile Manifest report issue that listed certain files multiple times. (EI-609)
- Fixed problems with generating some reports from Android Open Source Project annotation. (El-608, El-607)
- Implemented fixes for ElectricSimulator report issues that could cause the report to provide incorrect calculations. (El-606, El-555)

- When viewing Build properties > Environment, and then performing Copy to clipboard... > ... for cmd, every environment variable value was surrounded by double-quotes. This issue has been fixed. (EI-588)
- Changed the annotation metric that Insight shows as the build time so that it more closely matches the build duration reported by the Cluster Manager. The build time shown by Insight will consistently be slightly longer than the duration reported by the Cluster Manager. (EI-578)
- Fixed a sorting issue in the Jobs by Agents report. (EI-573)
- Implemented a number of minor fixes in the Navigation panel.
- After running a Derived Files Analysis report with one annotation file and then running the report with a different annotation file, the report would retain the previous report's information. (EI-524)
- Corrected minor issues associated with opening annotation files.
